



## Burlington County Board of Social Services

### Resolution No. 2026 - 2

#### Annual Schedule of Regular Meetings

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Board of Social Services, a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, with administrative offices located in the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, desires to afford the public the opportunity to be present at the meetings of the Board and to that end wishes to provide full and adequate notice to interested persons of the scheduling of said meetings in faithful compliance with New Jersey's Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Burlington County Board of Social Services, a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Burlington County Board of Social Services shall convene regularly once per month, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 44:7-7, on the dates and at the prevailing times listed below for the purpose of transacting the business of the Board and deliberating upon the matters over which it has jurisdiction pursuant to statutes and regulations of the State of New Jersey:

2. The Board may take official action at any meeting. Closed sessions pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., may occur at any meeting.

3. The Board's regular meetings will be held in-person at the Burlington County Human Services Facility, 795 Woodlane Road, Suite 100, Mount Holly (Township of Westampton), New Jersey, 08060-3335, telephone: 609-261-1000, extension 4708.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth above, the Board may from time to time: (a) convene special meetings to consider matters falling within the jurisdiction of said Board; and (b) reschedule regular meetings as needed, upon the provision of forty-eight (48) hours advance written notice of the time, date, and location of said special or rescheduled regular meeting, said notice to be given in the manner prescribed by N.J.S.A. 10:4-8.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth above, the Board may convene meetings without the necessity of providing notice in the manner prescribed by N.J.S.A. 10:4-8 to: (a) consider items listed in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.b.; and (b) deal with matters of such urgency and importance that a delay for the purpose of providing adequate notice would be likely to result in substantial harm to the public interest, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 10:4-9.b.

6. Within seven (7) days of the date of the adoption of this Resolution, a copy of said Resolution shall be: (a) posted on the Burlington County Board of Social Services official website; (b) prominently and promptly posted on a public bulletin board reserved for such or similar announcements and shall remain posted until January 21, 2027; (c) delivered to the *Burlington County Times*, the Board's official newspaper, and the *Courier Post*, the Board's alternate official newspaper; (d) filed with the Clerk of the County of Burlington; and (e) mailed to any persons who shall have prepaid to receive such notice.


7. Any person may request that the Board mail to him or her copies of the Annual Schedule of Regular Meetings, revisions thereto, and any other advance written notices of meetings upon prepayment by such person of five dollars (\$5.00) annually to cover the costs of providing such notice. Such notice requested by the news media shall be mailed free of charge. Requests for mailed notices described above shall terminate on December 31, 2026, but shall be subject to renewal upon a new request to the Board for the calendar year 2027.

8. The Director is hereby authorized and directed to take such steps as necessary and proper to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.


9. If any provision of this Resolution, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid by operation of law or by a Court or other tribunal of competent

jurisdiction, the remainder of the Resolution and the application thereof to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

10. All resolutions and parts of resolutions are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.
11. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
